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Behaviour System

At Marshfield Primary School we use a variety of ways to praise and reward children. We use stickers, certificates, raffles, good attendance awards and prizes. We provide an environment in which pupils feel emotionally and physically secure and have high expectations of pupils' behaviour, achievement and progress.

PICTORIAL SYSTEM

Each class has designed their own pictorial chart inspired by class's interests and ideas. The behaviour charts will be displayed in every classroom and children will be moved up or down their chart in recognition of the behaviour they display.



The 8 Personal Learning Goals that we promote from Nursery to Year 6 are:

**Morality, Communication, Cooperation,
Adaptability, Respect, Thoughtfulness, Enquiry,
Resilience**

DREAMS

In conjunction with these systems, we also use the DREAM acronym to promote positive behaviour. This is linked to the 8 Personal Learning Goals

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When children display a particular attribute they are awarded a ClassDojo point for that learning goal. Once a child has achieved 10 Dojo points for a specific goal they will receive a badge with the Learning Goal embossed on it.

Completion of each Learning Goal on Class Dojo will also result in a visit to the virtual reward shop where a prize can be chosen by the child. The points will be available to see on each class's Dojo page.

Being Brilliant certificates are awarded on a Friday to one child in each class for exhibiting positive behaviour, directly linked to one of the 8 Personal Learning Goals. These are celebrated with parents and carers virtually on our school Twitter page.



Marshfield Primary School has a clear Code of Conduct. This is displayed in every classroom. We do realise that there could be some incidences more serious in nature, that may warrant a pre-exclusion, internal exclusion or exclusion immediately. Racial and anti LGBT incidences are also recorded and the LA informed.
