

# Reading at Marshfield

## Reading at Home

- All children are encouraged to read at home every day.
- Children in Nursery - Year 2 to have 3 adult entries in reading record with 1 adult signature weekly.
- Children in Year 3 - Year 6 to have an entry with a child signature daily and 1 adult signature weekly.
- Records to be monitored and discussed with parents by teacher in the first instance and then SLT.
- Adult in school to read with child every day and add entry (decided using data)

## Teaching Reading

- Weekly reading lessons focusing on the explicit teaching of reading skills using CUSP (Y1-Y6).
- Reading comprehensions embedded within English and Curriculum lessons.
- Class novels shared and enjoyed; some year groups to use novels to inspire writing.
- CUSP reading spine in every class.
- Reading embedded in Curriculum, Science and English lessons.

## Reading in School

- Star reader test used to assess children's lexile level and reading age (Y2-Y6).
- Weekly reading time to encourage quizzes on Accelerated Reader (Y2-Y6).
- Half termly reward to Waterstones for children making progress in reading.
- Class library of books banded to lexile level using the Oxford book band.
- Each year group has a designated time to use the school library.
- A love for reading is nurtured and shared across school including through the exploration of authors and illustrators.
- Author visits and drama workshops linked to books.
